Key Focus Area: Environments

Environments are the facilities and general surrounds where people participate in sport and active recreation.

Critical Issue One

How to plan and provide for adequate facilities and environments?

Challenges

To identify future infrastructure priorities so that facilities meet the demographic and diverse needs of the community.

To plan for the development and management of the Marrara Sports Precinct to maximise the community benefits and utilisation of the area.

To develop a Remote Sports Facilities Strategy to address the needs of remote Indigenous communities.

To encourage and broker partnerships and agreements between organisations to share multipurpose facilities.

Critical Issues Two

How to improve access to facilities?

Challenges

To consider “healthy” options for venue management including non smoking venues, and the provision of healthy food and low alcohol beverages.

To increase the availability of open spaces and infrastructure for sport and active recreation activities, such as after hours school facilities.
